The Department of Coroner is soliciting Statement of Qualifications from qualified Criminalist/Consultants to work in the Toxicology Section of their Forensic Laboratory. Qualified candidates must have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college in Chemistry, Biochemistry, Biology or closely related field. Duties will include but are not limited to: perform chemical and instrumental analyses on post mortem specimens using instrumentation and techniques such as GC, GC/MS, LC/MS-MS, and Immunoassays. Desirable qualifications include experience handling human biological samples, knowledge of QA/QC and laboratory safety practices, and experience in a forensic or clinical laboratory. Successful candidates must be fingerprinted and pass a background check.

This is a three-year temporary position paid at an hourly rate not to exceed \$70,000 annually.
