

**Program Director - Forensic Science Facilities (Faculty equivalent/Academic professional)**

The Forensic and Investigative Science program at West Virginia University is seeking candidates for the position of Program Director AP (Director Forensic Science Facilities). The Forensic and Investigative Science program has 6 full-time faculty, 19 graduate students, and more than 350 undergraduate pre-majors and majors. The undergraduate program is accredited by FEPAC and has a new master's degree program. The Program has state of the art laboratories and equipment, as well as three crime scene houses and a vehicle processing facility. The education requirements include a Bachelor degree and 7-10 years of equivalent work experience. A Master's degree in a field relevant to Forensic Science is preferred. The successful candidate will begin their appointment in January, 2010.

This position is a full-time (12 month), benefits eligible, faculty equivalent and will be responsible for the day-to-day management of the Forensic & Investigative Science (FIS) Program. Some of the specific duties include: teaching regularly in the Forensic Program, overseeing the internship program, implementing accreditation requirements, overseeing the fiscal management of the FIS Program, supervising two full-time and one part-time FIS staff, maintaining computers, printers, and laboratory equipment, managing the Crime Scene Houses (currently 4 houses), working in conjunction with the FIS faculty to ensure the "crime scenes" meet their specifications, responsible for ordering, maintaining, transporting, and securing weapons for the Firearms graduate course, working directly with the WVU Police Department to ensure compliance, assisting graduate students in relation to weapons training and their firearms research projects, and assisting Forensic faculty regarding research projects.

The review of applications will begin on December 15, 2009 and will continue until the position is filled.
