Faculty responsibilities include teaching and advising master's students and participating and developing research projects in your relevant area, as well as service to the University and community. The George Washington University has an established graduate program in forensic science attracting students interested in forensic molecular biology from all over the United States and abroad. **Basic Qualifications:** a Ph.D. in biology, genetics, or molecular genetics or a related field, at least 5 years experience working forensic biology cases in a crime laboratory including presumptive and confirmatory testing as well as DNA evidence testing including STR testing and mtDNA testing.
