- Examines evidence for the presence of biological material and, when necessary, collects trace material.
- Performs serological and DNA testing.
- Interprets single-source DNA typing results to include making comparisons to known profiles, making determinations about the inclusion or exclusion of contributors and making determinations about profiles to be entered into the Combined DNA Index System (CODIS).
